In these press releases I prefer to write about the work and not the person. Except in this particular case I know even less about the work than I know about the person.

In his studio Matt showed me a work and he expressed his worry that he made it ‘too obvious’. I then proceeded to look at the piece of paper for a good minute without realising what I was supposed to see... When I did, however, I was stunned in silent admiration. What attracts me to Matt’s work, then, is an attention to almost imperceptible details, of working for a long time on aspects that are valuable but which others might not even notice.

As for the man, I’m somehow reminded of a phrase Baudelaire supposedly used to describe Delacroix, who according to him possessed ‘a kind of special goodness and tenderness that always accompanies genius’.

Between his own curating efforts and his excellent bookstore *BOOKS at*, I’ve come to appreciate Matt as a highly knowledgeable person, with a porous and receptive mind and a genuine interest in the doings of other artists. These qualities are surprisingly rare in the inward looking reality of the arts.

The show has been our own introduction to Matt Hinkley and his practice, and we hope this small exhibition can serve as a foundation for other works in the future.
